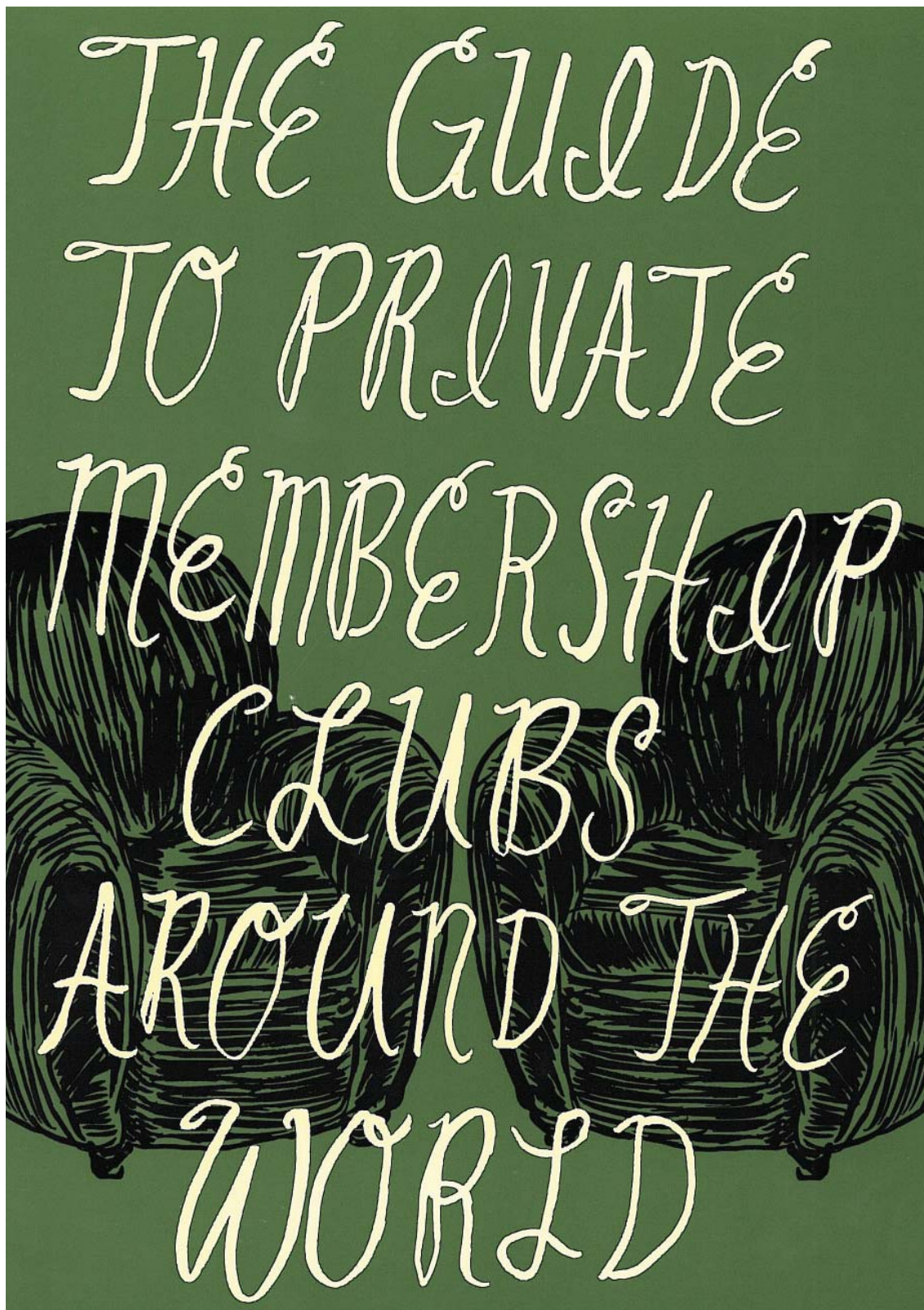

Orchard at the Carneros Inn

The Orchard, a private residence club adjacent to the famed Carneros Inn resort, sits amid a 27-acre vineyard that stretches across the border between the Napa and Sonoma valleys. Members can spend up to three weeks a year at the property's 17 two-bedroom cottages—each 1,250 square feet—with private patios. And they can now take advantage of a reciprocity agreement with Timbers Resorts; members can opt to take their allotted time in six other Timbers properties, in spots as far-flung as Tuscany, St. Thomas, and Cabo. Since the Orchard (and the Carneros Inn) is operated by the PlumpJack Group, the Gavin Newsom-founded family of wine and fine-dining experiences, members can access PlumpJack's oenological expertise on an intimate level. For starters, they have full access to all three of the Carneros Inn's restaurants, including its Hilltop Dining Room, with a wine list prepared by PlumpJack wine director Gillian Ballance. During the crush and harvest, members enjoy personalized visits to the original PlumpJack grounds and its new Cade winery—the latter is 100 percent certified by Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design. At Cade vintner Anthony Biagi walks them through the steps of creating wine. Orchard's concierge can arrange other personalized tours or an in-cottage food-and-wine pairing with the inn's executive chef, Jeff Jake. *Membership fee, from \$300,000.
